Strategic plan Horizon Europe 2025 – 2027

- **Stakeholders addressed:** political decision-makers, private investors, potential applicants, general public
- **International cooperation:** openness of Horizon Europe and multilateralism; development and use of Net Zero technologies; climate and environmental agreements (Africa Initiative, Mediterranean Initiative and a **new initiative between the EU, Latin America and the Caribbean**, PRIMA, Ukraine)
- Specific **cross-cutting issues:** Balance of R&I, integration of social sciences and humanities; dissemination and use of results
- **Synergies** with European and national instruments for funding and financing
- **New initiative** between the EU, Latin America and the Caribbean



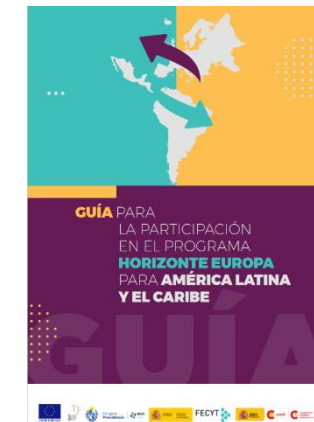

Horizon Europe 2025: some funding options for green topics

- **All parts of the 2025 Work Programme encourage international cooperation**, with particular emphasis on dedicated initiatives for cooperation with Africa, Mediterranean and **Latin America and Caribbean countries**.
- **Electromobility** in urban areas in emerging economies (Latin America) via specific workshops and events, mainly online (Global Gateway and the UN Global Environment Facility GEF).
- **AI for Public Good 2**: Innovative AI-powered solutions for emergency response and crisis management (deployment mainly in **Central America, the Carabean and Colombia**)
- HORIZON-CL3-2025-01-DRS-02: Open topic on Improving **disaster risk management** and governance to ensure self-sufficiency and sustainability of operations in support of enhanced resilience
- HORIZON-CL6-2025-01-BIODIV-09: Understanding the perceptions of and improving communication on the **biodiversity crisis and nature restoration** benefits to sustain citizen engagement and democratic governance
- HORIZON-MISS-2025-05-SOIL-02-two-stage: Broadening the living labs approach for **soil health** in Africa and **Latin America and the Caribbean (LAC)**
- HORIZON-MISS-2025-05-SOIL-05: **EU global footprint** on soils
